Great American Eclipse 2017 Exhibition

EXHIBITION: July 14 – August 26th, 2017

The Great American Eclipse exhibition is an opportunity for artists to exhibit their current artwork. Artwork of any medium may be submitted so long as the subject matter is inspired by the Eclipse. The actual eclipse will take place on August 21st. The show will be juried by a panel of scientists and artists.

Artwork will be sold OFF THE WALLS for this exhibition in order to take full advantage of the Eclipse itself, and the touring groups expected to visit Lander. Therefore, you may submit up to 6 pieces, and you may submit multiple versions of the same piece. Contact LAC staff for specific questions regarding your work.

If multiple versions of the same piece are submitted, only one will be displayed at a time. If your artwork sells, we will replace it with another one of your pieces.

Work older than three years or work already exhibited in a past LAC show will not be accepted. Artwork must have appropriate hanging system. Please see exhibition guidelines for full details.

- _____ I release the Lander Art center, its staff, members, employees, volunteers, and agents free and harmless from any loss, or damage that may happen to my art, or resulting cost or liability during the time that my art is shipped to, from, and during the stay at the Lander Art Center.
- _____ I also agree that this waiver and release is to be binding on my heirs and assigns.
- _____ I also agree to allow the Lander Art Center use of artwork images taken in conjunction with the exhibition, preparation and take down, for the purposes of promoting the exhibition during the exhibition and in the future.
- _____ Additionally, I allow the Lander Art Center to release my name, phone number, e-mail, and website address to the public for sales and promotion.
- _____ I have carefully read this agreement, waiver. And release and fully understand its contents. I am aware that this is a release of liabilities and a contract between the Lander Art Center, its staff, members, volunteers, and myself and agents and I sign it of my own free will.
- _____ I understand that my work is to arrive at the Lander Art Center by the end of the day on, **July 5** and will remain on exhibit through **August 26, 2017**, after which time it is expected that I pick up my artwork.
- _____ I understand that the Lander Art Center will encourage the sales of my artwork and will charge a 30% commission. The Art Center will not release art to a buyer without receiving payment and will pay me (the artist) at the beginning of the month following the exhibition takedown.

Exhibition Application Guidelines and Information

- Please electronically provide an artist statement or process/technique statement with your entry. (More information on how to write an artist statement can be found at www.landerartcenter.com/artiststatement)
- Artwork must have been completed in the last 3 years
- Artwork should be labeled on the back with artist name and title of work
- Artwork size limited to 48 inches for the largest dimension
- **Framed artwork hanging system should consist of eye hooks with wire and plexi glass**
- Artwork should be sufficiently packaged in a reuseable container (box) upon drop-off. Packaging should be labeled with artist's name and number of pieces.
- All types of media are accepted, but please see specific show guidelines for details. No printed copies of original artwork will be accepted.
- \$20 fee
- We encourage artists to submit artwork that is for sale. A special commission of 30% will be charged.
- *The Lander Art Center reserves the right to final curatorial and installation decisions.*

Display All works to be hung must be securely wired and ready for display. No picture frames with back stand will be accepted. We encourage simple, quality frames that reflects a level of professional presentation and not home décor. We urge you to use plexi glass instead of glass. All entries must remain on exhibit until the show closes. Artwork that is sold will remain until the show closes and at that time can be picked up or will be shipped to the buyer. Artists who desire to insure their work must make their own arrangements. The Lander Art Center will not be responsible in case of loss or damage. All reasonable care will be taken with entries.

Deadlines: Set exhibition deadlines are set to help our small staff manage a heavy and busy workload. It is very important that we receive your entry in the time frame we have indicated. Please consider this as you decide when and what shows to enter.
